I just received our latest Water Sample Results from SGS Canada Inc for Recreational purposes at Sturgeon Bay. Once again, the sites all were very good even with the extremely high, humid temperatures.

Water temperature that morning between 9am and 11am was 23 degrees, a light breeze was at all locations, no water fowl were present and brown Algae was found at all sites.

Readings under **100 e-coli per 100 ml of water** are considered safe for recreational purposes.
