Our usual samples of Sturgeon Bay water for recreational purposes results have definitely caught me off guard. After beautiful weather and all sites being quite active the days before plus the amount of brown Algae present at most sites, the numbers were exceptional! Remember though, a heavy rain or water fowl can alter the quality of the water substantially.

Readings under 100 e-coli per 100 ml of water are considered safe for recreational purposes.
