The Tobacco ties from last year will be taken down and the new ones put up. The purpose of the Tobacco ties is to put our prayers and good wishes into the tobacco for the healing that needs to happen with the Truth and Reconciliation work that is being done in Canada. So, on Jun 21st we can make those ties together.

The Committee is having the social at the same time as the Benny Club so that the parents and caregivers can come up and take part if they wish.
