

Water testing for Wednesday August 19, 2020

Hi Everyone,

I hope everyone is continuing to enjoy the summer weather. The temperatures have cooled off a bit during the day and the night, which has made it very comfortable for doing many activities.

When I tested the water this week, the weather was sunny and cloudy, a bit breezy with the air temperature at 19 degrees celsius. There were some waves in the water, but they were small as the wind was not too strong.

Here are the results from the water testing.

1) Old Cottage Lane	e-coli testing	10/100 ml
2) Forest Lane	e-coli testing	<10/100 ml
3) Lawson Lane	e-coli testing	<10/100 ml
4) Robin's Point Rd.	e-coli testing	<10/100 ml

As you can see from the test results, the e-coli readings are down significantly from the test that was done 2 weeks ago. I do want to mention that in locations #2 and #3 there was seaweed in the water, and on the shore, but I do walk out at least 2 feet to do the water testing in all of the locations. In location #4 there was a bit of seaweed in the water, but the bottom is very weedy. I have noticed in the past few weeks that large clumps of seaweed have been floating around the bay and then eventually making their way to the shoreline. The water temperature was 22 degrees celsius in all locations.
