Water Testing Report for August 5, 2020

Hi Everyone,

The weather is continuing to be hot and beautiful. I hope that you are all outside enjoying all of the outdoor activities.

When I tested the water on August 5, we had had quite a bit of rain the night before. The weather on the day that I did the testing was very windy, with sun and cloudy conditions, and the air temperature was 18 degrees celsius. Due to the wind, the water was very wavy. I was at least 2 feet deep or more in all of the areas.

Here are the water testing results.

1) Old Cottage Lane	e-coli reading	190/100
2) Forest Lane	e-coli reading	20/100
Lawson Lane	e-coli reading	220/100
4) Robin's Point Rd.	e-coli reading	150/100

As you can see, this has been the highest reading of the year. I am just speculating that this is due to the large amount of rainfall that the area had the night before and due to the size of the waves that obviously stirred up a lot of sediments.

The water temperatures at the locations #1 and #2 were 22 degrees celsius. At location #3 the water temperature was 21 degrees celsius and at the location #4 the temperature was 23.5.
