Hello Everyone,

I hope everyone is enjoying their summer so far...

The weather has been a little unpredictable with lots of rain in the last two weeks.

In the past testing, I have been taking water samples from 4 locations. This week and moving forward, we have decided to take a water sample near the Victoria Harbour wastewater treatment plant's discharge pipe that is located in Sturgeon Bay closer to Robin's Point Rd. side.

The testing was done on Monday July 12, 2021 at 8:45 am. It was a beautiful morning with sun and cloud and with an air temperature of 18 degrees celsius. The water was very calm with no wind.

Here are the results from the testing:

Old Cottage Lane	e coli reading	<10/100 ml
Forest Lane	e coli reading	<10/100 ml
LawsonLane	e coli reading	<10 /100 ml
Robin's Point Rd.	e coli reading	<10/100 ml
Discharge pipe	e coli reading	10/100 ml

The water temperature was a refreshing 21 degree celsius at all of the locations. There was no algae, no waves or geese at any of these locations. There were weeds that could be seen on the bottom at the discharge pipe location. No weeds were present at the other locations.
