The Directors voted to combine the positions of **Secretary/Treasurer** to facilitate local business and banking, and Director **Evelyn Roberts** has agreed to take on this combined role. **Victoria Reaume** has agreed to act as **President** on an **interim** basis, in order to ensure the smooth running of local projects, and to lead local communications with the Township.

Speaking of **LOCAL PROJECTS**, Talpines POA is launching its first ever “Talpines spring cleanup of the Trail and community”. With the gracious support of the Township, our Councillor Barry Norris, and Bryan Anderson of the Parks Department, Talpines volunteers are encouraged to **pick up litter along the Trail** and surrounding areas on Monday, **May 18**, 2020 from 9 to 4. **Clear bags** for recycling and **yellow bags** for litter have been provided by Tay Township and can be picked up on the Trail in front of 22 Old Cottage Lane. A table will be set up there. Tay Township will pick up the full bags of garbage at the Pine Street Beach on Tuesday, May 19, at the entrance to the pier.

To assist, a Director will also swing by to pick up the litter collected from the Trail at two additional points: at the gated entrance to the Trail at the Albin Loop, and at the Trail head parking lot on Coldwater Road.

This spring cleaning community activity qualifies for high school student volunteer hours so ‘WELCOME, STUDENTS!’

We can sign your sheet if you identify yourself at the table at 22 Old Cottage Lane.

Please wear gloves, and maintain all social distancing requirements. No large groups please!
