## WATER REPORT

Hello Everyone,

It was nice to welcome back summer, as we having been experiencing some very nice weather lately. I take water samples from 5 locations around Sturgeon Bay and send the water samples to the Aquatic & Environmental Lab in Barrie, where the samples are tested for e-coli.

Levels of an e-coli reading are of concern if they are 200/100ml or above.

The Simcoe Muskoka Health Unit does the water testing for e-coli at the Waubaushene beach. If there are issues with the safety of swimming at the beach, there are signs posted to reflect the concern.

On the day that I did the testing, it was a sunny morning with an air temperature of 15 degrees celsius. There was a slight breeze, so there was some small waves in some of the locations.

The water temperature at that time was around 20-21 degrees celsius. There was no signs of algae or weeds at this time.

Here are the results of the testing. Location

#1 Old Cottage Lane e-coli testing 80/100ml

#2 Lawson Lane e-coli testing 110/100ml

#3 Forest Lane e-coli testing 60/100ml

#4 Robin's Point e-coli testing 10/100ml

#5 Drainage Pipe e-coli testing <10/100ml
